

**POLICY ON B1 AND B2 SLIDES
CITY OF DEEPHAVEN**

The Council of the City of Deephaven hereby adopts the following policy on B1 and B2 Slides in St. Louis Bay and Carson’s Bay with the specific attempt to provide clarity to residents and current slide permit holders within the City of Deephaven.

Slide Classification

Slides shall be of two specific types – B1 Slides and B2 Slides. B1 Slides are designed for larger and wider boats than B2 Slides.

B2 Wide Boat Permits

A maximum of 29 B2 Wide Boat Permits could be issued for the 2007 Boating Season that would allow boats in excess of 5’4” to be moored on a B2 Slide. City Staff shall determine the maximum width of boats eligible to obtain a B2 Wide Boat Permit and the final number of B2 Wide Boat Permits that shall be issued for the 2007 Boating Season.

Boat Slide Standards

Slide Type	Maximum Length	Minimum Width	Maximum Width	Maximum Weight
B1 Slide	17’6”	Over 5’4”	7’	Owner must be able to pull the boat from the water manually or install winch system
B2 Slide	16’	N/A	5’4”	Owner must be able to pull the boat from the water manually
B2 Wide Boat Permit	16’	Over 5’4”	Staff decision	Owner must be able to pull the boat from the water manually or install winch system

2007 Slide and Permit Fees

B1 Slide - \$262.50
 B2 Slide - \$175.00
 B2 Wide Boat Permit - \$ 50.00

2007 Slide Configurations

B1 Slide - Ten 16’ wide pallets would accommodate a total of 20 B1 Slides in St. Louis Bay. Each 16’ wide pallet would contain two 8’ B1 slide spaces.

B2 Slide - Sixteen 16’ wide pallets would accommodate a total of 48 B2 Slides in St. Louis Bay and thirteen 16’ pallets would accommodate a total of 32 B2 Slides in Carson’s Bay. Each 16’ wide pallet would contain three B2 Slide spaces.

B2 Wide Slide - Sixteen B2 Slide spaces could be available in St. Louis Bay and thirteen B2 Slide spaces could be available in Carson’s Bay to accommodate residents obtaining a B2 Wide Slide Permit.

B1 Slide Approved Winch System

Approved winch retrieval systems shall be permitted but not required for the 2007 Boating Season.

B1 Slide Waiting List

There will be a separate waiting list for B1 Slides that shall be initially developed from the earliest date that a resident from the following priority grouping first accepted a slide:

Priority #1: Residents with a boat width in excess of 5'4" who accepted a slide prior to May 18, 2004.

Priority #2: Residents who accepted a slide after May 18, 2004.

Priority #3: Residents with a boat width at or less than 5'4" who accepted a slide prior to May 18, 2004.

2007 Eligibility for B1 Slide Spaces

Eligibility to obtain a B1 Slide Space for the 2007 Boating Season will be determined in the same manner as the priority for the B1 Slide Waiting List:

Priority #1: Residents with a boat width in excess of 5'4" who accepted a slide prior to May 18, 2004.

Priority #2: Residents who accepted a slide after May 18, 2004.

Priority #3: Residents with a boat width at or less than 5'4" who accepted a slide prior to May 18, 2004.

Prohibited Use of B1 Slides

All future buoy permit holders are prohibited from obtaining a B1 Slide Permit but are eligible to obtain a B2 Wide Boat Permit.

This policy was adopted by the Council of the City of Deephaven this 19th day of March, 2007.
