

**DEEPHAVEN CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2010  
MINUTES**

**1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** Mayor Paul Skrede called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m.

**2. UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

**A. Adopt Resolution No. 34-10, Canvassing Results of Municipal Elections**

Motion by Councilmember Kask to Adopt Resolution No. 34-10, A Resolution Canvassing the November 2<sup>nd</sup> Municipal Election Results. Seconded by Councilmember Wheaton. Motion carried 3-0.

Discussion was held about whether Steven Erickson might consider requesting a recount due to the fact that there was only a separation of 9 votes between himself and Darel Gustafson. Administrator Young stated that there is not an automatic recount for municipal office but the separation in votes was close enough to enable Mr. Erickson to request a recount and have the cost of the recount paid by the City.
