

## **DEEPHAVEN PARKING PERMIT INFORMATION – FOR RESIDENTS**

Parking permits are required to park at Deephaven beaches and parks and anywhere a sign is posted stating “parking by permit only” **from MAY 1<sup>st</sup> through OCTOBER 1<sup>st</sup> every year.**

These permits do not allow you to park in any “NO PARKING” areas.

Permits issued are good for one year only and expire at the end of that year. ALL EXPIRED PERMITS MUST BE REMOVED FROM YOUR CAR.

### **PROPERTY OWNERS -**

**Property Owners are mailed ONE parking permit every spring, around April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year, along with an application to request additional permits if needed.**

If you require additional permits you must fill in the application sent to you and send in to city hall.

The second permit you request is FREE. For a third permit, or more, the cost is \$10.00 each.

**Each car you apply a parking permit to must be registered to your Deephaven address.**

**If you ask for a second permit, or more, you must provide a license plate number for every permit you receive, including the first permit we mailed to you.** You must provide all license plate numbers for each permit you receive every time you apply for additional permits. (ex. If you request a 4<sup>th</sup> permit – you must provide license plate numbers for all three cars you’d gotten permits for earlier)

Registration checks will be made on all applications for additional permits and persons whose vehicles are not registered to them will be required to provide proof of ownership.

**If you own property, but do not reside in Deephaven, you may obtain ONLY ONE free permit** – each additional permit will be charged at the NON-RESIDENT cost. You must apply for your one permit at city hall and provide ID. Your name must be listed as the property owner with Hennepin County and at City Hall prior to obtaining your permit.

### **RENTERS**

Parking permits are mailed to owners only, with no attempt to reach tenants.

If you have a tenant, or are a renter, you must apply in person for a parking permit(s) every year, with TWO FORMS of ID showing that you reside in Deephaven.

### **IT IS ILLEGAL TO SELL, ASSIGN OR OTHERWISE TRANSFER A PARKING PERMIT (Ord. #450)**

Vehicles parked in permit zones are randomly checked by the police to ensure that the registration of the vehicle license number matches with the parking permit number on the car. If the permit displayed on a vehicle which is registered to someone other than whom the permit was issued, the vehicle is subject to a **TAG AND TOW.**

### **PERMIT PLACEMENT**

**ALL EXPIRED PERMITS MUST BE REMOVED.** Peel the permit from the backing paper and place it on the OUTSIDE of the window on the **DRIVER’S SIDE OF THE VEHICLE AS FAR TO THE REAR AS POSSIBLE** (ex: the back seat **SIDE** window)
