Vandalism Report - Information	2014-04-01	Officer was approached by a resident that said a bear hide that was given to his son had been vandalized and ruined. Officer responded to the residence and spoke with the reporting parties to gather information. Officer took the information and completed an informational report.

	Traffic Stop - DAR/Possession Drug Paraphernalia	2014-04-04	Citation - Driving After Revocation/ Possession Drug Paraphernalia/ Passing in a no passing zone.
	Traffic Stop - DAS/False Information/Arrest	2014-04-04	Vehicle was stopped for headlight out and registered owner showed a suspended drivers license status. Driver stated the vehicle was his brothers and gave his name as the brother of the registered owner. After investigation driver was found to be the owner of the vehicle and was arrested for false information to police. Driver was transported to Hennepin County Jail and booked.
	Traffic Stop - Curfew/Paraphernalia/False information Arrest x2	2014-04-05	A vehicle was stopped by an officer for an equipment violation. After investigation an odor of narcotics was detected in the vehicle and all the occupants were removed. While doing a probable cause search of the vehicle, one of the occupants fled on foot. The two others were detained and the search turned up numerous items of paraphernalia. An adult passenger was ID'd and released and the juvenile driver was released to his parents with a citation for his offenses. The party that fled was eventually located at his residence and denied involvement. He was ID'd and issued a citation via mail for his offenses.
	Damage to Property Report	2014-04-05	Officer on patrol noticed a city sign that had been destroyed presumably by a car running off the road into it. Officer documented the damage and wrote up a city work order to have the sign replaced
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-04-06	Verbal Warning - fail to signal, Curfew Violation (x2)
	Welfare Check - Indecent Exposure Lewd Act/Disorderly Conduct	2014-04-12	Officer responded to a welfare check of a male standing outside a passenger car in the Deephaven Elementary School parking lot vomiting. Upon arrival Officer found a male and female engaging in sexual relations in the passenger car parked in the school parking lot. Both parties involved were under the influence of alcohol. Male and female were cited for various violations and transported to a gas station to obtain a ride home.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal Warning	2014-04-12	Vehicle stopped because RO was suspended. Driver was son of RO and out past curfew.

			Warned for curfew.
	Traffic Stop - 3x Curfew/ 2x Underage Consumption	2014-04-13	Officer stopped vehicle for driving conduct and speeding. Further investigation found all 3 occupants in the vehicle were juveniles and out past curfew. 2 juveniles were found to be under the influence of alcohol and all 3 juveniles were cited and released to parents at the scene.
	DWI / Underage Drink & Drive	2014-04-13	19 year old driver was stopped for weaving and was arrested for DWI. Officer found a small amount of marijuana, drug paraphernalia, and two pellet pistols during an impound inventory. Driver submitted to a breath test with a result of .06. Driver was released pending a formal complaint for the above violations.
	Traffic Stop - Underage DWI/Warrant Arrest	2014-04-15	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a lit cigarette was seen thrown from the vehicle and after poor driving conduct was observed. After investigation, the 19 year old driver was found to have two outstanding warrants and to have consumed alcohol. The driver was placed under arrest for the warrants and underage drinking and driving. An 18 year old passenger was cited for underage consumption and released from the scene on foot. The vehicle they were driving was impounded as no sober adult could be found to move it from the stop location. The arrested party was then transported to jail where he was booked for the warrants.
	Harassing Communication	2014-04-18	Officer dispatched to a harassment complaint. Victim reports that he has been contacted by Suspect repeatedly and wanted it documented. Officer arrived and met victim and gathered information. Report filed
	Phone call- Harassing Communications	2014-04-18	Victim calling to report a student of hers was starting to act strange and calling her at all hours of the night, caller believes the suspect even came to the studio where she works but was unsure. Officer spoke to Veteran Services and gathered the information. Case inactive at this time as V.A. wants to handle it on their end.
	4th degree DWI Arrest	2014-04-18	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after observing poor driving conduct. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI and was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver

			submitted to a breath test with a report result of .15 BAC. The driver was tab charged for 4th degree DWI and careless driving and was released to a sober party.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-04-20	Verbal Warning - follow too close, Curfew
	Indecent Exposure	2014-04-23	PD received a report from Minnetonka PD on an indecent exposure incident they investigated before determining the incident occurred within the City of Deephaven, near the Minnetonka border. The case will be referred to the city attorney for charging.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-04-25	Citation - Fail to stop for Semaphore / Possess small amount marijuana in motor vehicle
	3rd Degree DWI - Refusal Arrest	2014-04-25	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a seatbelt and equipment violations were observed. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI and transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver refused to provide a sufficient breath test after being given two attempts and was charged with test refusal. The driver was transported to Hennepin County Jail where he was booked for 3rd degree DWI - test refusal, 4th degree DWI, careless driving, no seat belt and expired registration.
	Damage to property	2014-04-26	Officer dispatched to a property damage report. Officer arrived and found RP on site and found 4 mailboxes and the posts they were mounted to on the ground. The night before Minnetonka arrested a suspect for DWI, and we had determined that this suspect had struck the mailboxes. Suspect to be charged with Damage to Property.
	Flee Police/3rd Degree DWI Arrest	2014-04-27	Officer was checking businesses and observed a vehicle traveling at a very high rate of speed on Minnetonka Blvd. The vehicle then failed to stop for a stop sign and continued traveling at a high rate of speed. The officer attempted to stop the vehicle and as he did, the driver turned off the headlights, parked in a driveway and fled on foot into a house; refusing commands to stop. A search of the house turned up the driver hiding in the basement under a sheet. The driver was placed under arrest for fleeing police in a motor

				vehicle and DWI. The driver was transported back to the police department and consented to a breath test with a reported result of .13 BAC. The arrested party was transported to Hennepin County Jail and booked for the above offenses.
