	4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-07-01	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after an equipment and moving violation was observed. After investigation, the driver an 18 year old Edina woman was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver elected to submit to a breath test with a reported result of .07 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving, under 21 drinking and driving, possession of an open bottle and was released to a sober adult.
	Theft	2016-07-05	An officer took a report of a license plate stolen off a vehicle.
	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2016-07-08	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on routine patrol after poor driving conduct and equipment violations were noticed. After investigation, the odor of narcotics were detected in the vehicle. The driver was removed, the vehicle was searched and drug paraphernalia was located. The driver was issued a citation for the possession of the paraphernalia and released from the scene.
	4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-07-09	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after moving violations and poor driving conduct was observed. After investigation, the driver a 48 year old Deephaven man was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was left parked at the scene and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver elected to submit to a breath test with a reported result of .14 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving and was released to a sober party.
	Traffic Stop - DAS/Narcotics	2016-07-13	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after multiple equipment violations were observed. In making contact with the vehicle, the odor of narcotics was detected and the occupants were removed for a vehicle search to be done. After investigation, narcotics were located in multiple locations in the vehicle as well as open containers of alcohol and the driver was found to have a suspended license. All occupants were cited for a number of offenses and the vehicle was released to a valid passenger. See report for further information.

	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2016-07-15	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after a stop sign violation was observed. In making contact with the vehicle, the odor of narcotics was detected and the occupant was removed to perform a vehicle search. After investigation, marijuana and drug paraphernalia was located in several locations in the vehicle. The driver was then issued a citation for possession of a small amount of marijuana in a motor vehicle, possession of drug paraphernalia and stop sign violation before being released from the scene.
	4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-07-16	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after a moving violation was observed. After investigation, the driver a 24 year old Minnetonka man was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was left parked at the scene and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver elected to submit to a breath test with a reported result of .09 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving, failure to obey a traffic control device and was transported home.
	Attempted Theft	2016-07-17	An officer was dispatched to the general store for a report of an attempted theft involving two young males, it was reported all parties were at the store. An officer arrived on scene and spoke with all parties involved, the victims, along with the suspects and their parents came to an amicable conclusion and didn't request charges for theft.
	4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-07-20	An officer overheard a call dispatched to the SLMPD in regards to the report of a possible impaired driver that had been mixing alcohol and prescription medication and left a residence in Greenwood enroute to a store at an unknown location. The officer was requested to check the area for the vehicle and in doing so, located a vehicle that matched the description that was given by the RP. The officer observed poor driving conduct and conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. After investigation, the driver a 40 year old Greenwood man was found to be under the influence of narcotics and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department where a drug recognition expert responded and performed an evaluation. After the evaluation, the DRE advised that the driver was impaired on narcotics and a search warrant was drafted for a blood draw to be completed. A blood sample was then drawn from the party and they were booked and released while

			awaiting formal charges once the blood sample has been analyzed by the BCA.
