INCIDENT	DATE REPORTED	INCIDENT DETAILS
----------	---------------	------------------

	Identity Theft	2014-07-02	Resident reported their identity being stolen to make purchases on credit cards and cash advances in their name totally \$15,000 dollars. Resident was advised to make a police report about the incident from their bank. Investigation pending.
	Trespassing	2014-07-03	An officer on patrol noticed a group of individuals trespassing and shooting off fireworks from under the new bridge construction on the LRT. The officer checked the area but was unable to locate the group as they had fled while officer was trying to get down onto the trail. Further investigated only turned up the remnants of the fireworks that were shot off.
	Traffic Stop - Underage drink and drive/Narcotics/Underage Consumption	2014-07-04	Officer stopped a vehicle for a trailer light malfunction. The driver was cited for underage drink and drive, possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle, possession of drug paraphernalia and open container. The four passengers were charged with underage consumption.
	Traffic Stop - DAS-Tab charge	2014-07-04	Officer stopped a vehicle for faulty trailer lights. Upon further investigation the driver was found to be suspended. The driver was tab charged for DAS and possession of drug paraphernalia.
	Theft- Unfounded	2014-07-05	Resident left a message on the PD voice mail reporting the theft of his American flag that was hanging above his garage door. Resident called back later and said the wind blew the flag onto his roof. No theft took place.
	Disturbance - Disorderly Conduct and Trespassing Arrest	2014-07-06	Officer was called to the Main Beach for a disturbance. A person at the beach who was acting inappropriately and had been told to leave several times and was still there. Officer told the male to leave several times and he refused. The male was placed under arrest for trespassing and disorderly conduct and transported to jail.
	Damage To Property	2014-07-06	Officers were dispatched to a damage to property report where a mail box had been blown up by a firework. No suspects were located and no contact was made with the

			property owner. A door hanger was left at the scene requesting the property owner to contact the Police Department. No further contact was made.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-07-08	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the driver was found to be 16 and out past curfew. The driver was issued a citation for the equipment violation and verbally warned for curfew and violating the terms of her provisional license.
	4th Degree DWI Arrest	2014-07-10	An officer on routine patrol came across an occupied vehicle parked with a male driver passed out behind the wheel. After investigation, the driver was found to be intoxicated and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver submitted to a breath test that came back with a result of .12 BAC. The driver was tab charged for 4th degree DWI and was released to a sober party.
	Traffic Stop - Curfew Citation x2	2014-07-14	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the three occupants, all juveniles were arrested for curfew related offenses. The group was cited and released after making contact with parents.
	4th Degree DWI Arrest	2014-07-14	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a registration check showed the registered owner of a vehicle's license was suspended. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI and transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver submitted to a breath test that came back with a reported result of .17 BAC. The driver was tab charged for 4th degree DWI, driving after suspension, careless driving and possession of an open bottle.
	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Arrest	2014-07-14	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a vehicle was observed being driven by an individual known to the officer as one driving without a valid driver's license. After investigation, the driver was found to

			be revoked and had no insurance on the vehicle and was placed under arrest for those offenses. While doing an inventory of the vehicle, methamphetamine was located in the vehicle, as well as a stolen license plate. The driver was transported back to the police department and eventually to Hennepin County jail where he was booked for probable cause 2nd degree controlled substance - possession methamphetamine.
	Theft	2014-07-17	Resident reported that last night someone entered his property and stole a 28 gallon gas caddy and two tackle boxes. The items were left outside by the garage. No suspect information.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-07-18	A vehicle was stopped by an officer for a moving violation. After investigation, the driver was found to be 16 years old and on her way home from work. The officer warned the driver for all offenses and advised her to do a better job of getting home before curfew.
	Recovered Stolen Vehicle - Arrest	2014-07-18	An officer on routine patrol ran a license plate that came back as a stolen motor vehicle out of Sherburne County. A felony traffic stop was conducted on the vehicle as it pulled into the driveway of a residence. Once assistance from Minnetonka PD and SLMPD arrived onscene, three parties were removed at gunpoint from the vehicle and secured in separate squads. The vehicle was cleared and a further search turned up drug paraphernalia in the trunk. One passenger was ID'd and released from the scene and another was cited for the possession of drug paraphernalia and released. The driver was arrested for possession of a stolen motor vehicle and eventually transported to Hennepin County jail and booked as such.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-07-19	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the driver was warned for the traffic violation and both driver and passenger were warned for violating curfew. The duo was advised to head straight home.

	3rd Degree DWI Arrest	2014-07-19	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI and was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver eventually submitted to a breath test that came back with a result of .13 BAC. The driver had one prior DWI and was tab charged for 3rd degree DWI and was booked at Hennepin County Jail.
	Theft Report	2014-07-19	Officer dispatched to a reported theft from an unlocked residence. Officer arrived and met with the RP who said money had been taken out of a drawer over the course of the last three weeks. Officer took the information and gave the RP her case number. Unknown suspect(s).
	Traffic Stop - DAC IPS Arrest	2014-07-19	Officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Upon further investigation the driver was found to be Cancelled IPS. The driver was arrested and booked at HCADC.
	Identity Theft	2014-07-22	Resident stopped at the PD to report an incident of identity theft. Someone used the victim's bank routing and account numbers to make a purchase of \$2256.85 from Sprint. Investigation Continues.
	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation x2	2014-07-24	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after two equipment violations were observed. In making contact with the vehicle, the odor of marijuana was detected in the vehicle, the occupants were detained and the vehicle was searched. After investigation, the driver and passenger were both cited with narcotics related offenses and several pieces of paraphernalia were seized.
	Theft	2014-07-24	Resident had an acquaintance stay at her home for a few days in June. After the party had left she noticed items were missing. Report was taken and investigation pending.
	Underage consumption-Citation	2014-07-24	Officer on routine patrol of beaches encountered a group of adults on the beach after hours. During identification of the subjects, officer could smell a consumed alcoholic beverage on one person. All persons submitted a PBT and only one had

			consumed alcohol. Subject was cited and released.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-07-25	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the driver was found to be out past curfew. The driver was warned for the violations and told to go straight home.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-07-25	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the vehicles occupants were found to be out past curfew. The driver was cited for expired registration and both were issued verbal warnings for the curfew violation.
	Traffic Stop - Citation x2	2014-07-29	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a moving violation was observed. After investigation, the vehicle was found to be occupied by two juveniles out well past curfew. The parents of both parties were contacted and advised of the situation. The driver was cited for speeding, warned for curfew and released from the scene. The passenger was cited for curfew and was released to his parents.
