INCIDENT	DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2014- 06-05	Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and upon further investigation marijuana was found in the vehicle. The driver was warned for speeding and cited for small amount of MJ in a motor vehicle.

	Traffic Stop - Citation/Medical	2014-06-06	Officer stopped a vehicle for failing to dim lights. Upon further investigation the driver was found to be underage and possessing alcohol. The driver was cited for under age possession of alcohol and warned for failing to dim lights.
	Vandalism	2014-06-06	Officer patrolling beach area noticed a garbage can in the water. Upon further investigation the officer found a total of three cans and a picnic table in the water. The north end of the swimming dock was separated from the beach. Officer spent a considerable amount of time in the area looking for suspects but was not able to locate any. Officer had been through the area at 23:50 hours. Officer photographed the cans and table.
	Damage to property	2014-06-10	Officer dispatched to a burglary. Officers found the house vacant and empty. Officer photographed the door and a partial shoe print. There are no known suspects at this time. Officer advised the owner.
	OFP Violation	2014-06-10	Resident called to report a violation of an order for protection involving her minor children.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-06-12	Verbal warning - license plate light, fail to signal turn, curfew x3
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-06-13	Verbal Warning - headlight, curfew
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-06-14	A vehicle was stopped for moving and equipment violations. After investigation, the driver was cited for speeding, 48 mph/35 mph zone and both the driver and passenger were issued verbal warnings for curfew violations.
	4th Degree DWI Arrest	2014-06-14	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a moving violation and poor driving conduct was observed. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI and was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver submitted to a breath test with a reported result of .12 BAC. The driver was tab charged for 4th degree DWI, careless driving and speeding and was released with a court date to a sober friend.
	Suspicious Activity	2014-06-18	A vehicle was stopped by an officer, after it was observed occupied and parked in front of a closed business. Contact was made with the lone occupant, who was 16 years old and claimed to be "waiting for a friend". Officer advised the driver that she was out past curfew and that it wasn't wise to park in front of closed businesses. The driver was warned for the curfew violation and advised to go home.

	Suspicious Activity - Citation x3	2014-06-19	An officer on patrol noticed a suspicious occupied vehicle parked on the roadway. After investigation, contact was made with three juveniles out well past curfew. The group advised they were waiting before going to a friend's house. All three individuals were cited for curfew violations, released and advised to go home.
	Traffic Stop - Formal Complaint- GM No Insurance	2014-06-21	Driver stopped and warned for brake light out. Passenger, who was the owner of the vehicle, had no insurance on the vehicle. The vehicle was impounded and the driver, who had several prior no insurance convictions on his record, was transported to the PD and was booked and released pending a formal complaint.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-06-23	Verbal warning - license plate light, curfew
	Traffic Stop - Suspicious Act	2014-06-25	Officer heard Minnetonka PD get a call of a male trying to sell marijuana at local gas station. Officer found the vehicle on Hwy 7 a short time later and stopped the vehicle in Excelsior with assistance from SLMPD officers. The vehicle was searched and a small amount of marijuana and drug paraphernalia was found. The driver was cited for these offences and the rental company who owned the vehicle was contacted and wanted the vehicle towed back to their office for non-payment by the renter. The evidence was seized and secured in the PD property room.
	4th Degree DWI Arrest	2014-06-28	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after observing multiple moving violations. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI and transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver submitted to a breath test that came back with a reported result of .18 BAC. The driver was tab charged for 4th degree DWI, careless driving and failure to stop at a stop sign and was released to a sober friend.
