	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2016-09-03	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a moving violation was observed. In making contact with the driver the odor of narcotics was detected in the vehicle. The driver was removed and the vehicle was searched. After investigation, a small amount marijuana was located. The driver was issued a citation for speed 72 mph/55 mph zone and possession of a small amount of marijuana and was released.
	Traffic Stop - Tobacco Citation	2016-09-03	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the driver was found to be a juvenile out past curfew in possession of tobacco that was visible in plain view. The tobacco was seized and the juvenile was released to his parents with a citation.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2016-09-10	Citation - failure to signal turn, Verbal Warning - Curfew and provisional DL violation
	Domestic Assault - Arrest	2016-09-13	An officer was dispatched to a report of a past action domestic assault with the victim removed to another residence. The officer responded to the scene and investigated the report. After the investigation a male was arrested for domestic assault related charges.
	Traffic Stop - DAC-IPS Arrest	2016-09-15	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after a registration check showed the RO of a vehicle had a cancelled-IPS license status, an outstanding warrant for their arrest and the registration had been flagged to be impounded. After investigation, the driver a 30 year old Minnetonka man was placed under arrest for DAC-IPS and the warrant. The license plates were seized from the vehicle and it was impounded. The driver was then transported to Hennepin County jail where they were booked for the above charges and the warrant.
	Traffic Stop – Narcotics Citation	2016-09-17	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the odor of narcotics was detected and drug paraphernalia was found to be in plain view in the vehicle. The occupants were removed and the vehicle was searched. Upon completion of the search, the driver was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia and released.
	Fire - Arson	2016-09-19	An officer was dispatched to a report of a possible grass fire on Cottagewood Road. An officer responded to the area and found a home owner in his front yard, the officer observed a fire. Upon investigation it was found that a political sign had been set afire. The sign and grass were extinguished by the officer.
	4th degree	2016-09-24	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after an

	DWI Arrest		equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the driver a 24 year old Hopkins man was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver ultimately submitted to a breath test with a reported result of .08 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving, possession of drug paraphernalia and was released with a court date to a sober party.
	Illegal Dumping - Tree Trimmings	2016-09-26	An officer on patrol observed illegal dumping at Rocky Beach, tree trimmings near the roadway in the parking lot. A maintenance request was filled out for Public Works to remove the debris.
