|  | Damage to Property                | 2016-08-02 | RP called to report the mailbox post he shares with three other neighbors had been knocked over. Officer arrived and photographed the mailboxes on the ground. None of the boxes appeared to be damaged. RP said he was not concerned about the cost to repair the posts because it was an old set and needed to be replaced. Officer estimated cost to replace the post at \$100.00 for time and material. RP said he was advised by the Post Office to file a report.   |
|  | Traffic Stop - Verbal warning     | 2016-08-03 | Verbal Warning - fail to signal turn, Curfew  |
|  | Traffic Stop - Verbal warning     | 2016-08-03 | Verbal Warning - expired tabs, Curfew   |
|  | 3rd degree DWI Arrest             | 2016-08-07 | An officer on patrol conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after poor driving conduct was observed and the vehicle was found to be driving on a flat tire. After investigation, the driver, Avery Rebecca Amorosi, 19 of Excelsior was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver elected to submit to a breath test with a reported result of .16 BAC. The driver was then transported to the Hennepin County jail where they were booked for 3rd degree DWI, careless driving, under 21 DWI and possession of an open bottle. |
|  | Traffic Stop - DAR/Narcotics      | 2016-08-13 | A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a registration check showed the RO of a vehicle had a revoked driver's license. After investigation, the driver was found to be the RO and there was a strong odor of narcotics in the vehicle. The driver was removed, a vehicle search was done and it turned up a small amount of marijuana. The driver was cited for DAR, the marijuana possession and was released. The vehicle was left legally parked until a valid driver could be located.   |
|  | Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation | 2016-08-27 | A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the odor of narcotics was detected in the vehicle and it was searched. A further search of the vehicle turned up marijuana. The driver was issued a citation for possession of a small amount of marijuana in a motor vehicle and released from the scene.  |
