Officers arrived on scene and conducted an investigation. The driver who struck a vehicle was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was arrested. The

4th degree DWI Arrest	2016- 11-13	A vehicle was stopped by an officer working a traffic detail after a speeding violation and poor driving conduct was observed. 	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2016- 11-01	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after an equipment violation was observed. In making initial contact with the vehicle, the officer could detect the odor of narcotics in the vehicle and the occupants were removed to conduct a search. After investigation, the officer located paraphernalia and a small amount of marijuana. Both the driver and passenger were issued citations for possession of drug paraphernalia and were released from the scene.

	Information- Damage to Property- Political Sign	2016-11-07	Caller reported that a large Trump political sign had been vandalized sometime this weekend. Unknown date or time. Unknown person(s) had spray painted a Swastika in black paint on the sign. Unknown dollar amount in damage.
