Vehicle was stopped and driver was investigated for driving under the influence. Driver was found to be intoxicated and over the legal limit. The driver, Pepe Malo Babadjide , 29 of Chanhassen, was arrested and transported to the Deephaven Police Department. Driver submitted to a breath sample and the results were .10 AC. Driver was cited and booked for 4th Degree DWI and released. |
