	3rd degree DWI - Refusal Arrest	2016-12-03	A vehicle was stopped by an officer working a traffic detail after poor driving conduct was observed. After investigation, David Frank Chapman, 35 years old, from Spring Park, MN was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported to the police department for further testing. After being read the implied consent advisory, the driver refused to submit to a breath test. The driver was then transported to Hennepin County jail where they were booked for 3rd degree DWI test refusal, 4th degree DWI and careless driving.
	4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-12-23	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after a moving violation was observed. After investigation, the driver, Jonathan F Kumlin, 47 of New Richmond, WI. was found to be under the influence of alcohol and placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver elected to take a breath test that came back with a reported value of .14 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving, speeding and released with a citation.

Underage Consumption	2016-12-03	An officer on patrol saw what appeared to be juveniles walking in the street. The officer saw one of the juveniles throw a bottle of alcohol into the ditch. The officer stopped the juveniles and issued several citations for under age alcohol offenses.
Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2016-12-09	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after an equipment violation was observed. In making contact with the vehicle, the odor of narcotics was detected and the occupants were removed so that a vehicle search could be conducted. After investigation, several pieces of drug paraphernalia were located and seized. The driver was issued a citation for possession of the paraphernalia and released.
