3rd Degree DWI - Refusal Arrest	2017-06-04	Officer on patrol traveling west bound Hwy 7 approaching Vine Hill Rd. observed a passenger vehicle weaving, driving onto the shoulder and crossing into the other lane. Officer stopped the vehicle and investigated the driver for DWI. Field sobriety tests were administered and the driver submitted a breath sample for a PBT. Results were .240 AC. Driver was arrested for DWI and the vehicle was impounded. Driver was booked at the Deephaven Police Department. The driver, Selena Rae Anderson age 21, of Hopkins refused the breath test and was taken to Hennepin County Jail for 3rd degree DWI test refusal.
Welfare Check- 3rd Degree DWI Arrest	2017-06-15	Officer s received a traffic complaint of a reported driver all over the road and hitting No Parking signs. The vehicle and driver were located at a residence in Deephaven. The vehicle was found parked in the garage and an adult female admitted to driving the car. After investigation the female, Barbara Merrill Webster age 74 of Deephaven was arrested for 3rd degree DWI. Test result of .18 AC.
