Traffic Stop - Narcotics Arrest	2017-03-08	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on routine patrol after a moving violation was observed. In making contact with the occupant, the odor of narcotics was detected in the vehicle and the driver was removed to conduct a vehicle search. After investigation, the driver a 23 year old Maple Grove man was placed under arrest for possession of a controlled substance - marijuana wax. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported to Hennepin County Jail where they were booked for the possession of a controlled substance.
Traffic Stop - Narcotics Arrest	2017-03-10	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after moving violation was observed. After investigation, the driver a 17 year old Excelsior female was placed under arrest for possession of narcotics as well as possession of alcohol and other offenses. A passenger was cited for possession of alcohol by minor and released to her parents. The vehicle was released to the registered owner and the passenger was transported back to the police department where they were booked before being released to her parents.
Traffic Stop - Minor Consumption Citations	2017-03-18	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after a moving violation had been observed. After investigation, the odor of alcohol was detected in the vehicle and two juvenile females were found to have been consuming alcohol and were issued citations underage consumption.
