4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-10-01, 0201 hours	A vehicle was stopped by an officer on patrol after poor driving conduct was observed. After investigation, the driver, Cory Alan Svihla , 28 of Eden Prairie man was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver ultimately submitted to a breath test with a reported result of .10 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving and was released with a court date to a sober party.
4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-10-07, 2031 hours	A vehicle was stopped by an officer working a traffic detail after several moving violations were observed. After investigation, the driver, Phiphop Phillip Sengchanh , 37 from Minneapolis was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported to a local police department for further testing. The driver elected to submit to a breath test that came back with a reported result of .12 BAC. The driver was booked for 4th degree DWI, careless driving, speeding and was released with court date.
3rd Degree DWI - Refusal Arrest	2016-10-09, 1938 hours	Officer heard SLMPD Officers dispatched to an east bound driving complaint on Hwy 7 from Eureka Rd in Shorewood. Officer waited at Hwy 7 and Vine Hill Rd. and observed the suspect vehicle stopped at the stop light. Officer followed the vehicle east on Hwy 7 from the stop light and observed poor driving conduct. Officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and the driver admitted to consuming alcohol prior to driving. Male driver performed field sobriety tests and failed. Male refused to submit to a preliminary breath test and was arrested for DWI. Male was brought to the Deephaven Police Department and was read the Minnesota Implied Consent Advisory. Male refused to submit to a breath test. Male was booked at Hennepin County Jail for 3rd Degree DWI and Test Refusal. Austin Kenneth Lowell Mounts, 26 of Rockwall , TX.

	4th degree DWI Arrest	2016-10- 23, 0156 hours	A vehicle was stopped by an officer working a traffic detail after a speeding violation and poor driving conduct was observed. After investigation, the driver, Rachel Rose Christensen , 19 of Plymouth was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was placed under arrest for DWI. The passenger, also a 19 year old woman from Plymouth, was found to be under the influence of alcohol and was issued a citation for underage consumption and released to a sober family member. The vehicle was impounded and the driver was transported back to the police department for further testing. The driver elected to take a breath test with a reported result of .09 BAC. The driver was then booked for 4th degree DWI, underage DWI, careless driving, speeding- 90 mph/55 mph zone and was released to a sober party.
