

**CITY OF DEEPHAVEN
RESOLUTION NO. 14-20**

**A RESOLUTION ENACTED UNDER AUTHORITY OF MINNESOTA STATUTES
SECTION 12.29 AND 12.37 TO EXTEND THE PERIOD OF A MAYOR-DECLARED
LOCAL EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Deephaven has found the following situation exists:

- Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019, commonly known as COVID-19 or the coronavirus, a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death is a new strain of virus that had not been previously identified in humans and can easily spread from person to person.
- The U.S. Center for Disease Control has identified the potential public health threat posed by COVID-19, and has advised that person-to-person spread of COVID-19 will continue to occur.
- The State of Minnesota has had an increasing number of positive test results for COVID-19.
- The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Secretary declared a public health emergency for COVID-19 on January 31, 2020.
- President Donald Trump declared that the COVID-19 outbreak in the U.S constitutes a National Emergency on March 13, 2020.
- Governor Tim Walz declared a Peacetime State of Emergency to authorize any and all necessary resources to be used in support of the COVID-19 response on March 13, 2020.
- Hennepin County declared a local emergency in response to the COVID-19 outbreak on March 17, 2020.
- National Center for Disease Control and Prevision and the Minnesota Department of Public Health recommend that any individual with confirmed COVID-19 should remain under home isolation precautions until the risk of secondary transmission to others is thought to be low.
- The necessary resources to respond to and recover from this pandemic will exceed those available within the City, and additional resources will be needed from outside the City, including from county, state, and federal sources.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has declared that the situation is a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Deephaven agrees with the Mayor's findings and further finds that the situation will last for more than three days;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEPEHAVEN, MINNESOTA AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council declares that the situation constitutes a local emergency continuing until July 6, 2020.
