Summary:

In the month of September the department had a spike in calls for service. Generally our calls will go down once school is back in session. Citations written dropped to average levels. We saw another spike in agency assists. South Lake was short staffed in September and they had some serious calls where back-up was needed.

The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of September 2014:

Incident	Date	Incident Details
Traffic Stop - Insurance Demand Form	2014-09-03	Officer stopped a vehicle for failing to dim high beams. During the stop the driver was unable to provide proof of insurance and the Officer confirmed the driver was uninsured. Upon further investigation the driver was found to be in possession of an open bottle of alcohol and marijuana.
Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-09-04	Citation - Underage Possession of alcohol, Possession of paraphernalia and speed (65/50)
Traffic Complaint - Citation	2014-09-05	An officer was flagged down by a citizen to advise they had nearly been struck when a vehicle passing them crossed the center line. The officer was able to locate and stop the vehicle and found the driver to not be impaired. A vehicle search was conducted after the odor of marijuana was detected in the vehicle. Upon completion of the search, the driver was issued a citation for possession of drug paraphernalia and released from the scene.
Burglary- Unfounded	2014-09-05	Officers were dispatched to a residence in Woodland after the RP reported hearing a door close in her residence. Upon arrival of the officer's, a perimeter was set up. A K9 officer was called in and cleared the residence. No signs of forced entry and no one was located in the house. Call was Unfounded.
OFP Violation	2014-09-10	Person stopped at the PD to report a violation of an order for protection. Report was taken and it was determined that no violation occurred.
4th degree DWI- Arrest	2014-09-10	Vehicle stopped for driving conduct. Driver admitted consuming alcohol prior to driving. Investigation found the driver to be under the influence of alcohol and was arrested for DWI. Driver transported to Deephaven PD for paperwork and testing. Driver submitted to a breath test with a .09 AC result. Driver was tab charged and released.
Theft Report	2014-09-12	An officer was dispatched to the report of stolen property. The RP reported that his scooter was stolen from the boat

			launch area on Water St. The officer checked the area but was unable to locate the scooter. A report was taken in regards to the theft.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-09-15	A vehicle was stopped by an officer for a moving violation. After investigation, the driver and passenger were found to be out past curfew and also in possession of tobacco. The driver was cited for speeding and both parties were warned for the curfew and tobacco violations. Both parties were advised to go straight home.
	4th degree DWI Arrest	2014-09-18	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after a moving violation was observed. After investigation, the driver was placed under arrest for DWI. The arrested party was transported back to the police department for further testing. The arrested party consented to a breath test with a reported result of .16 BAC. The driver was tab charged for 4th degree DWI, careless driving and speeding and was released to a sober party.
	Suspicious Activity- Beach after hours	2014-09-21	Officer observed 2 vehicles parked at Nocomo Beach after hours. Officer located a male and female in the back seat of a one of the vehicles. Officer identified the parties and warned them of park hours and curfew. Both left the area and headed home.
	Theft From Auto	2014-09-21	Resident reported a theft from auto last night. CD's, \$30 cash, prescription medication and sunglasses were taken from the vehicle. The vehicle was unlocked and parked in an unlocked, detached garage. No suspect information at this time. Total loss is \$470.
	Theft From Auto	2014-09-21	Resident called and left a message on the PD voicemail that someone stole items from his vehicle last night. Missing are 2 pair of tennis shoes, an Ipod case and a bank statement. Total loss is \$221.00. No suspect information at this time.
	Tamper with motor vehicle - Phone call	2014-09-21	Officer dispatched a phone call regarding a tampering with a motor vehicle. Officer phoned the RP who said her car had been gone through during the night. RP had checked her car and said nothing had been taken.
	Stolen Vehicle Report/ RECOVERED	2014-09-25	Officer dispatched to a reported stolen automobile. Officer arrived and gathered information from the victim. A car theft report was completed and a teletype was issued.
	Attempted Stolen Auto	2014-09-25	Officer dispatched to an attempted auto theft very close to another auto theft report. Officer arrived and found vehicle in the driveway. Hennepin Co Crime lab was started to the scene and processed a portion of the vehicle but did not find any fingerprints.

	Suspicious Vehicle- Verbal Warning Curfew	2014-09-27	An officer on patrol came upon an occupied suspicious vehicle parked in the lot of the elementary school. The officer made contact with a juvenile occupant who advised she was there with friends who were "going to the bathroom" and "walking around the school". Contact was eventually made with three more juvenile individuals who stated they were supposed to be sleeping over at a friend's house and "needed to get away for a little while". All the individuals were ID'd and spoken to about being out past curfew and the ramifications for doing so. After the group was spoken to, they were sent on the way and advised to return to the location they are supposed to be at and remain there for the night.
	Theft From Auto	2014-09-27	Officer was dispatched a theft from auto report. The theft happened at an unknown time and date. The RP advised that he was aware of the theft however he didn't report it. The RP explained he received a phone call from a Carver County Deputy saying he recovered tools with the RPs name on them.
	Traffic Stop - Narcotics Citation	2014-09-27	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after multiple moving violations were observed. After investigation, the officer detected the odor of narcotics in the vehicle and it was searched. Once the search was complete, the driver was released with a citation for possession of a small amount on marijuana.
	Subject Stop- Verbal Warning Curfew	2014-09-28	Officer observed a juvenile male and female walking on Vine Hill Rd just after curfew. Juveniles were taken back to the responsible parties residences and parents advised of curfew.
	Traffic Stop - Verbal warning	2014-09-28	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, it was found the vehicle was occupied by two juveniles out past curfew. The juveniles were both warned for being out past curfew and the driver was issued a verbal warning for the equipment violation.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-09-28	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the vehicle was found to be occupied by four juvenile males out well past curfew. The group advised they were heading one of the passengers house to stay for the night. The driver was issued a citation for fail to dim hi-beams and the occupants were issued a warning for being out past curfew.
	Traffic Stop - Citation	2014-09-28	A vehicle was stopped by an officer after an equipment violation was observed. After investigation, the vehicle was found to be occupied by three juvenile females out well past

				curfew. The group advised they were heading to one of the passengers house to stay for the night. The driver was issued a citation for no front plate and the occupants were issued a warning for being out past curfew.
